DO NOT RECYCLE:

NO HARDBACK BOOKS, FROZEN FOOD OR FOOD-CONTAMINATED BOXES



NO PLASTIC PAILS, TUBS, TRAYS, FOOD CONTAINERS OR FOIL ITEMS

IMPORTANT: The recycle symbol & number do **NOT** always mean that we can recycle a plastic item. **DO NOT RECYCLE #1 & #2 TUBS AND TRAYS AND ANY #3 THRU #7 PLASTICS.**

We must sort these items out at the recycling center and send them to the landfill.



NO MUGS, GLASSES, VASES, BULBS, BAKEWARE, DISHES OR WINDOW GLASS



NO PLASTIC, STYROFOAM, LIDS OR CAPS



NO MOTOR OIL, LUBRICANTS, PAINT OR PESTICIDE CONTAINERS



NO PLASTIC BAGS

They jam up our sorting equipment. Recycle them at grocery stores instead.



PUT RECYCLING CURBSIDE BY 6AM

BOTTLES, CANS AND BEVERAGE, SOUP & SAUCE CARTONS

PLEASE RINSE
LABELS ARE OKAY

NO CAPS OR LIDS

DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS

REMEMBER

One truck collects paper – another collects bottles & cans



Set cart at least 3 FEET from buckets, mailboxes, basketball systems, cars, etc.

PAPER

PUT ALL PAPER/BOXES IN BLUE CART

FLATTEN BOXES SO EVERYTHING FITS

SET CART OUT WITH METAL BAR FACING THE STREET

Recycling containers are municipal property

If used for trash, they will not be collected

If you move, your cart must stay behind
