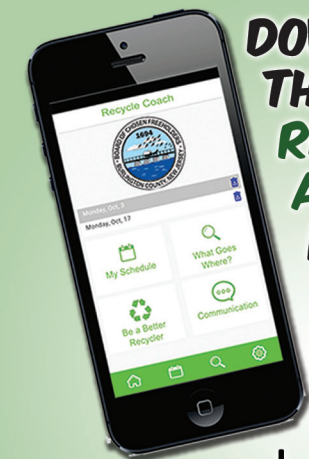

Freeholder Director Kate Gibbs: Now is the time to **RECYCLE RIGHT**

In 2017, Burlington County's recycling program diverted 42,000 tons from the landfill and saved taxpayers \$3.3 million in disposal fees. Unfortunately, outbound shipments of recycled materials from the United States are increasingly being rejected by recycling mills across the globe due to contamination. We're combating that issue here in Burlington County with our 'Recycle Right' initiative. Please help us by following the guidelines below:

RECYCLE:

Paper and Flattened Cardboard



Plastic Bottles and Food Containers

Empty and rinse containers.



Glass Bottles and Jars

Labels are okay!



Metal CANS Only

Other metal items can harm workers and equipment.



Cartons



SET RECYCLING OUT BY 6 AM
Metal bar must face the street.

DON'T RECYCLE:

NO hoses, cords, hangers, etc.



NO hardback books, food soiled, or frozen food boxes



NO wax coated cardboard

NO foil items



NO bulbs, glassware, or window glass



NO motor oil, pesticide bottles, or propane tanks



NO batteries



NO plastic with a  (like Styrofoam)



NO plastic wrap/sleeves

NO plant pots, trays, or bulky plastics



NO lids/cups/straws

NO shredded paper
